

# Tender Announcement from General Directorate of Turkish Coal Enterprises

Turkish Coal Enterprises (TCE) announced a royalty tender regarding establishment of a coal-fired thermal power plant in city of Kutahya. Deadline for submission of bids is 26<sup>th</sup> March 2013, 14.00 and bids will open on the same date at 14.00.

Bid bond value of the project is TRY 3.000.000 and tender document fee is TRY 2.000.

Technical information regarding tender is available to study at the General Directorate Building in Room 1412.

## Information About Project

General Information:

The area is licenced to Turkish Coal Enterprises with number IR:4364-S:36111. North parts of the specified area will be tendered and minimum installed capacity of the coal-fired thermal power plant must be 300 MW. It will be a royalty tender based on *kr/kwh* with annual increase indexed to consumer price index. Initial contract will be for 30 years with an option of extension under the same circumstances at the end of contract period if there is still available coal reserves.

General Directorate of Mineral Research and Exploration, Western Region Lignite Enterprises and private companies have done surveys on the field since 1967 and drilled 377 boreholes. According to these studies, calculated coal reserve is 114.418.000 tons.

Presence of coal varies between 412-850 meters depth. Zone thickness varies between 0.70 and 45.25 meters where average coal thickness is 7,53 meters.

**Location:**

The field is in Kutahya city and located between Tavsanlı and Domanic districts. The road between Kutahya city center and Tavsanlı is asphalt which enables transportation during whole year. Railroad is also available in the region. Altitude of the field from the sea level is between 650 and 1000 meters.
